Slow moving Frances soaked the southeast and produced significant storm surge

SEPTEMBER 5, 2004

- **Category 2 Storm**
- **Landfall near Stuart, Florida**
- **States Impacted: Florida, Georgia, Alabama, South Carolina, North Carolina**
- **Storm Surge — nearly 6 feet, widespread heavy rains, freshwater flooding, with maximum 18.07 inches at Linville Falls, North Carolina**
- **More than 100 tornadoes reported**
- **U.S. insured damages \$5.8 billion**
